Re. CFTC v. Hunter Wise Commodities, LLC, et al.
New Trial Date: February 24, 2014

Dear Customer,

I am writing to you in connection with the action of CFTC v. Hunter Wise Commodities, LLC, *et al.* (the "CFTC Action"), in which the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida (the "District Court") entered an Order Temporarily Appointing Special Monitor and Corporate Manager Melanie E. Damian (the "Monitor/Manager"). This matter was originally set for the two-week trial period commencing August 26, 2013 (DE 19). The Court granted a motion for a continuance because of a health condition regarding one of the Defendants, resetting the trial for the two-week trial period commencing October 7, 2013 (DE 204). The Court granted a second continuance after disqualifying counsel for certain of the Defendants, resetting the trial for December 2, 2013 (DE 210).

On November 19th, the Court granted a third continuance to provide those Defendants with additional time to retain new counsel. The two-week trial period is currently set to commence on **February 24, 2014**. With the trial in this matter having now been continued three times, the Court advised the Parties that no additional continuances will be granted, absent exigent circumstances.
