(the "CFTC Action"), in which the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida (the "District Court") entered an Order Temporarily Appointing Special Monitor and Corporate Manager Melanie E. Damian (the "Monitor/Manager").

On August 9, 2013, Defendant Martin, by and through his legal counsel, filed a Motion to continue the trial in this matter due to health problems. The District Court granted Defendant Martin's Motion and the trial period, previously set to commence on August 26, 2013, was CONTINUED to the two-week trial period commencing October 7, 2013.
